Rooms

Chalet Rive Gauche sleeps 10 people in 5 bedrooms.

Bedroom one
Double bedroom on third floor; en-suite shower room.

Bedrooms two, three and four
Double bedroom with king-size or twin beds on the first floor; en-suite shower rooms.

Bedroom five
Bunk room to sleep two in adult-size bunk rooms, wash basin in room and WC across the corridor. This room would be most suited to children or a nanny.

A private chef is at your service throughout your stay at this luxury ski chalet in Val d'Isere. In the mornings you'll enjoy freshly prepared breakfasts including yoghurt, fruit, fresh bread and pastries or if you feel like something a bit more hearty why not opt for bacon sandwiches or smoked salmon and eggs on toast. When you return in the afternoons a warming afternoon tea with hot drink will be ready and waiting for you.

On one evening of your choice, champagne and canapés are served, and it's not just any old bubbly. All the champagne is delivered direct from a boutique champagne house in the Grand Cru village of Ay.

Location

Chalet Rive Gauche is in the Le Fornet hamlet of Val d'Isere, at the bottom of the blue Mangard ski run, just 300m from the cable car. In good snow conditions you can ski right back to the door at this luxury ski chalet.

The centre of Val d'Isere is a 7 minute chauffeured drive away.

Chambery airport is just under 2 hours drive away whilst Geneva is approximately 3 hours away.
